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
Let's go to a doctor's practice

swollen lymph nodes in the neck and armpit and groin




Any Idea? qualche idea?

Three specific complaints:






Kaposi's sarcoma is a type of cancer that people with AIDS often get.

The patient needs treatment in hospital






Outpatient clinic infectous diseases infectious diseases specialist and nurse, twice a year a medical check up

How can you transmit the HIV virus from person to person?



HIV transmission through:

- → Kissing?
- → By food (bleeding wound of the cook)?
- → Mosquitoes?
- → Shake hands with someone who has HIV?
- → Using a public toilet?
- → Coughing, like a cold?

HIV transmitted because of unsafe sex -This wouldn't happened if you don't do that









HIV is also possible transmitted in the syringe

-Medical professionals never use the same syringe, only drug user do












Blood transfusion. (does not happen often nowadays)



Transfer from mother to child during pregnancy or during delivery. (Except when the mother uses HIV inhibitors, transfer is no longer possible)





Blood - Blood contact. For example, when caring for or printing wounds. Both parties must have a bleeding wound. (is very rare)









How can you prevent the transmission of the HIV virus?




Use a condom / Condoom gebruiken / usa un preservativo







Using the contraceptive pill. This prevents pregnancy, but does not prevent STIs.
